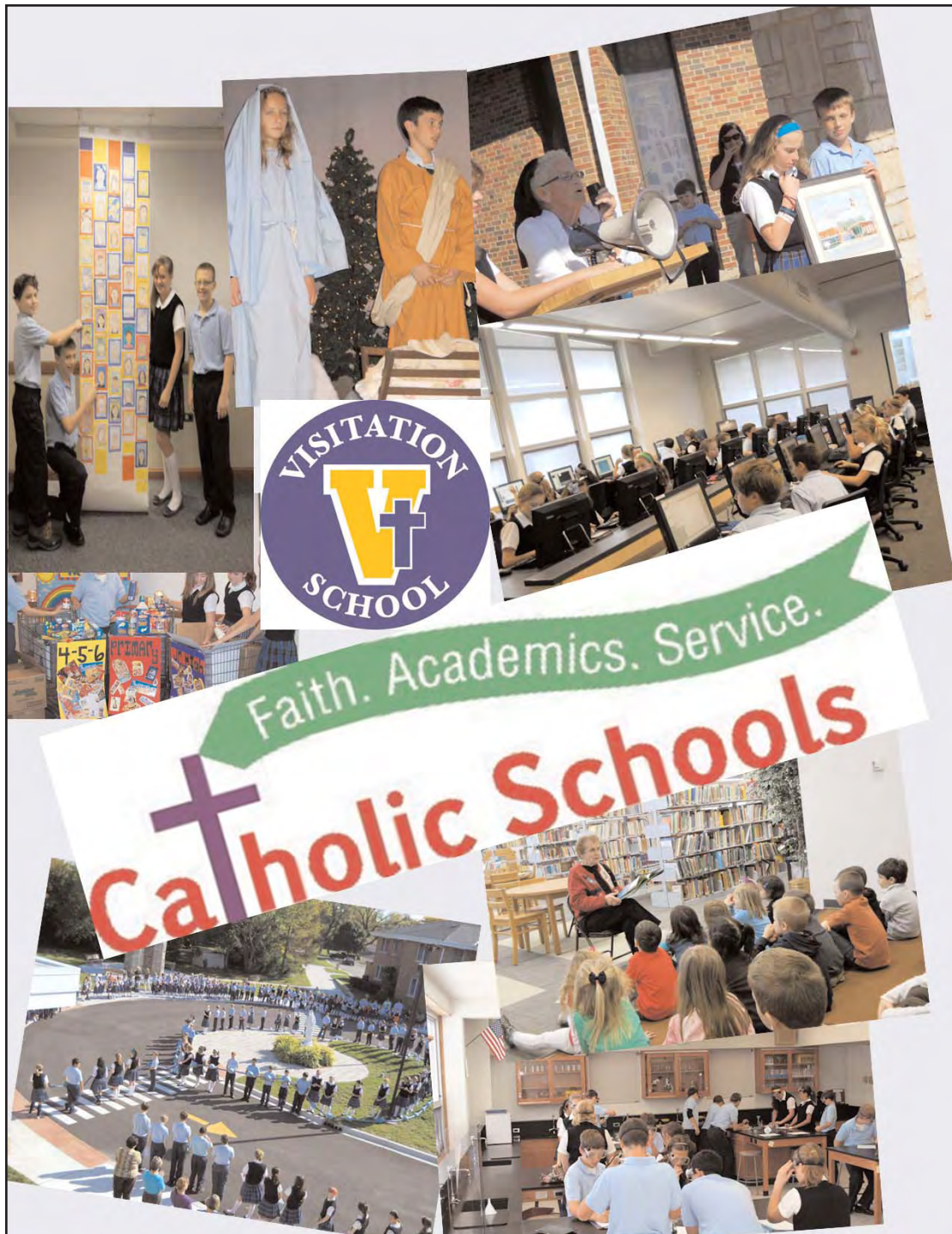

### Feast of the Presentation of Our Lord

#### *Candlemas Day*

**Thursday, February 2**

**Thursday, February 2, is the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord Jesus in the Temple, traditionally known as Candlemas Day. Candles for use in your home will be blessed and made available at the 6:15 A.M. Mass and the 8:15 A.M. Communion Service on Thursday.**

In the days before the reform of the liturgy (prior to 1963) all of the candles to be used in church for the coming year would be blessed on this day. Also on this day we bless the candles used for the Feast of St. Blaise, on which we give the traditional blessing of throats, using blessed candles. It's easy to see why on such a day when candles are so much a part of the day's celebration that the popular name for the Mass celebrated on this feast day is called "candle-Mass", hence the name Candlemas Day.

**Friday, February 3, is the Feast of St. Blaise, a Bishop and Martyr of the early Church. For many centuries St. Blaise has been the patron saint of those with ailments of the throat. He has been the saint to ask for prayers to protect you from throat ailments and every other illness.**

**The Blessing of the Throats will be held on Friday at the 6:15 and 8:15 A.M. Masses.** Please bring friends and family and join us to ask for the intercession of St. Blaise and for the healing touch of the Lord in our lives.

## SPRED (Special Religious Development)

SPRED (Special Religious Development) is a program in which persons who are developmentally disabled come together with a spiritual friend/catechist to share a one-on-one relationship and form with others a small faith community.

SPRED fosters and nourishes spiritual and personal growth by helping those with developmental disabilities discover God's action and presence in their lives. SPRED gives developmentally disabled parishioners an opportunity for celebration and worship and prepares them for the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation and Holy Eucharist) and Penance. SPRED serves age groups from children to adults (6-10 years old, 11-16 years old, 17-21 years old, and 22 years and older).

### R.E. & Visitation School Tuition Assistance Program

This past week 40 Visitation Grade School and other organization program families purchased \$15,460 in gift certificates through our MANNA program.

The earned tuition credit for the past week was \$725. The main purpose of our program is the assistance it offers families of the Visitation School. Families outside the Visitation School may also participate in our program if they home school, are in the Religious Education program, have students in a Catholic high school or college, or have a newborn child who will be attending Visitation School or Religious Education in the future. Parishioners may also participate in the program by purchasing our gift certificates through our Walk-in Service and having the credit earned applied to any family they care to assist and who are within any of the categories mentioned above. We have some helping others in our program now, and think this is one area where we can expand our services. Please give it some thought. Helping another is a great thing and remember, it does not cost you a dime since you receive store and restaurant certificates at a dollar-for-dollar face value.

### Catholic Reading Club Selection For February 2012 St. Thomas Aquinas *The Dumb Ox* by G. K. Chesterton

In his book, *St. Thomas Aquinas, The Dumb Ox*, G. K. Chesterton provides a biographical sketch of St. Thomas Aquinas (1225-1274) and demonstrates how this saint most clearly and profoundly expressed the Medieval philosophical program to synthesize faith with reason and revelation with philosophy.

St. Thomas revolutionized Medieval philosophy by promoting Aristotle's philosophy (the belief in an essential unity of body and soul), which acknowledged the fundamental goodness of nature and the necessity of the material realm for humanity.

Chesterton offers this short biographical sketch of St. Thomas's life as an introduction to his philosophy, which in turn gives us a brief glance at his theology. 'GKC places particular emphasis on Aquinas' doctrine of the "goodness of creation."
